Mountain Operations Update

We're excited to welcome skiers and snowboarders back to the mountain on November 27! Winter has officially arrived, and our Mountain Operations team has been hard at work, taking full advantage of every weather window for snowmaking and packing down the natural snow that has fallen. So far this season, we've received 35 inches of natural snowfall and began snowmaking in late October.

Nighttime temperatures have been favorable for snowmaking, while daytime temperatures have remained warmer. Despite this, our teams have done an excellent job maximizing snowmaking efforts. We've already completed snowmaking on Gold Dust trail and are currently working on the Base Area in Beaver Creek Village and Sawbuck trail in Bachelor Gulch. On the Birds of Prey World Cup course, Golden Eagle, we're nearly finished with snowmaking on the race course itself and will soon begin covering Solitude, the Grand Traverse in Red Buffalo Park, and Red Tail.

With temperatures looking favorable this week, we will continue productive snowmaking and will look to focus our attention on additional terrain beyond the main Beaver Creek Mountain. For opening day, we plan to open Gold Dust and Haymeadow and with a little help from Mother Nature, we also expect to open terrain off the Cinch Express Lift in Red Buffalo Park.

We look forward to seeing you on the slopes.

Short Term Vacation Rentals in Beaver Creek

Is your Beaver Creek property a Short Term Rental (STR)? If YES, do you know you are running a business within the resort of Beaver Creek?

Beaver Creek bylaws require your STR to have an Annual Beaver Creek Business License. The Beaver Creek bylaws also require your STR business to submit Civic Assessments and Lodging Assessments (which VRBO and AirBNB do not remit) based on your frequency of Colorado Department of Revenue sales tax submissions. These assessments uphold community enforcement and resort integrity, contributing to the exceptional guest and owner experiences in our world class resort.
